THE UBC AUDIOVISUAL TEAM IS HATCHING A PLAN?


With new volunteers stepping up to serve in the UBC Media team, we are immensely thankful!

Some highlights from those meetings.

- **Appreciation** was expressed for those who helped with the **deep clean of the kitchen and lower level** following over two years of little or no usage in preparation for Good Friday Services. *Ask Rod about doing dishes!*
- Anett Joseph, Coordinator for the Outreach Project, met with the Board to discuss the development of a Single and Young Parents' Group. funded by CBOQ grants.
- The **Annual Meeting** will be combined with the church barbeque, to be held after the morning church service on **June 26th**.
- A new Committee has been formed to organize a **newcomers' meeting/event.**
- Identified was the need for a **Chair for the Personnel Committee**. Sincere **thanks** to **Lloyd Beilhartz** for his dedicated expertise and leadership in this important aspect of church life.
- Pastor Gabriel hosted the **Sault Ste. Marie Evangelical Ministerium** meeting at UBC on April 12th in the lower level.
- Pastor Gabriel will meet with the **CBOQ Accreditation Committee** on April 26th. The last step for his accreditation will be completion of a Baptist History course available in the fall.
- The **Social Committee** expressed **deep appreciation to all** those who helped in so many ways as we were finally able to host **our traditional 50+ year combined Good Friday** Service with **Willowgove United,** on hold since 2020, due to Covid restrictions.

 A time of fellowship followed the Service and hot cross buns served.

- Being explored is holding a 1 or 2-week Vacation Bible School for children during the month of July.

Virginia gave a **devotional.** She read scriptures from Ephesians that were letters written by Paul to The Ephesians and graciously shared two of her original poems with us. **Thank you** Virginia.

Our guest speaker, **Anett Joseph** was introduced. She is the church's **Project Co-- Ordinator** who was hired to spearhead and organize the outreach initiatives as outlined in one of our three successful **submissions** to CBOQ for **grant funding**.

The plan is to connect **senior women**, both from within the church as well as from the community, with **single and young parents**, to **share expertise**, **learn new skills-** parenting, budgeting, shopping, cooking.

The discussion revolved around beginning with a small group- within our own church first to better determine the needs, with friendships hopefully developing, and progress from a small group into the larger community. With approval from the Board of Management, a letter of request has been sent to CBOQ for permission to adjust our plans as stated in the original submission. Anett was thanked by Susan and presented with —none other than— Scrubbies — both an original as well as a new addition to the Scrubbie family as designed and created by our own Lorraine Smith. With Covid restrictions lifting, we hope to initiate some projects in the near future.

Minutes from the virtually held **World Day of Prayer** (March 4th) were read. A total of 25 women *and one dog at Holy Trinity*, participated for the **six Hill Area Churches**. Our thanks to **Pastor Gabriel** for facilitating Zoom.

The Treasurer's Report was presented by Shirlianne, - we have \$1,884.42 in the General Account.

Susan reported on **Strategic Giving** – with ongoing support for **Missing Tribe** and **Soura Widows** projects in India. We traditionally have a **"Talent Sale"** at our June meeting, hoping to raise \$250 for each.

With the horrific crisis in **Ukraine**, a donation of \$300.00 was dropped off at St Mary's Ukrainian Church, made out to **CNEWA** from which \$0.95 of each dollar is sent to Ukraine, and \$0.05 kept for administration.

It's time to renew subscriptions for **LIVE** magazine @\$20.00- cheques payable to **Verna Scott** or cash, can be left in the box provided in the Narthex.

Samples of **Scrubbies**, **reusable paper towels** and **dish cloths** were shared from Sharon's daughter-in-law, Rebecca Burns who resides in Michigan and generously donates quality handmade items to our Brunch sale. We each took some home to do a "**test run**", promising to report results to Sharon for possible inclusion in our annual November **Fundraiser for Missions sale**.
